Sun Metro Connects Community with New William Beaumont Army Medical Center

City Offers New Transit Option For Veteran Community

EL PASO, Texas —Sun Metro will be providing a new transportation option for the new William Beaumont Army Medical Center (WBAMC), beginning August 31, 2022.

Residents who receive medical care at the new military hospital are encouraged to call Sun Metro TODAY to learn about the upcoming transit options, including how to schedule service Monday through Friday for upcoming healthcare appointments.

“At Sun Metro we value El Paso’s active military and veteran community. This new service connects the public to the new WBAMC, fills a service gap for our residents, and strengthens our partnership with Fort Bliss,” said Ellen Smyth, Chief Transit and Field Operations Officer for the City of El Paso.

The change aims at expanding transportation options for those members of the El Paso community who rely on the healthcare services offered by the military hospital located at 18511 Highlander Medics Street.

The LIFT paratransit service will also provide service to the new WBAMC from Monday through Friday and will be available for all El Paso citizens who qualify for the existing paratransit services.
