Sun Metro Modifying Operating Hours Starting February 12, 2025

Temporary Schedule Change Necessary Due to Impact from Fire to the Transit Operations Center

EL PASO, Texas—All Sun Metro Fixed and Brio routes will be operating on a Sunday/Holiday schedule starting Wednesday, February 12, 2025.

The temporary change to the operating schedule will remain until Wednesday, February 19, and is necessary due to the impact of the fire at the Transit Operations Center, at 10151 Montana Avenue.

"Our hearts and prayers are with the Sun Metro team members, who were injured in the incident at the Transit Operations Center. We are keeping them and their families in our thoughts," said City Manager Dionne Mack. "As we work through this challenging situation, riders may experience service impacts, including delays on some routes. We appreciate our riders' patience and understanding during this difficult period. We also are deeply grateful to our first responders for their swift action and support."
