
Come experience something uniquely





Hop on our vintage cars that in days of old transported riders internationally over the Rio Grande between El Paso, Texas and Ciudad Juárez, Chihuahua, Mexico. These cars—featuring original color schemes from the 1950s, 60s and 70s and modern amenities, such as wifi—now connect El Paso's Downtown and Uptown regions.

Streetcars looping through 4.8-miles of track carry residents and visitors to shops, cafes, bars, restaurants, hotels and other popular spots on the Texas side of the U.S.-Mexico border.

The routes consist of 27 stops to provide riders with easy and convenient access to the Downtown's Arts District, Paseo de las Luces and the Convention Center, as well as Uptown's historic Sunset Heights Neighborhood, the University of Texas at El Paso and the Cincinnati entertainment area.

STREETCAR PROGRAMMING

Each month the Streetcar hosts special events and tours that appeal to visitors and residents of all ages. Two of the Streetcar's signature events are:

Read+Ride: A free family-fun partnership with the El Paso Public Libraries where children listen to stories as they make their way along the tracks. Read+Ride is hosted once a month. Boarding locations vary.








Trolley Tracks: Free live music performances showcasing local artists set the good vibes for passengers and provide memorable rides. Concerts are open seating on a first-come, first-served basis. Most performances take place on Streetcar 1511, which offers circular seating so everyone can feel like they have a front-row seat.

STREETCAR AUDIO TOURS

Passengers can enjoy a self-guided audio tour along the nearly 5-mile long route by downloading the Visit El Paso App, available for both Android and iOS devices.

The El Paso Streetcar Audio Tour allows riders to choose their adventure by selecting the Downtown or Uptown tour options. Just hit the listen button and start your journey of the area's history and architecture.
